

When you are booking a rental car through Enterprise, you may be asked whether or not you want additional insurance.

In accordance with FAM Policy #4125, Executive Government carries third party liability insurance and vehicle damage insurance. This insurance coverage is in excess of the insurance provided by Enterprise. The current insurance coverage mirrors the coverage that was in place when short term rentals were provided through the Central Vehicle Agency.

Executive Government has determined that the levels of insurance that are now in place are adequate and meet Government's needs, therefore, no additional insurance should be purchased from Enterprise related to short term vehicle rentals.

In the event an Executive Government employee is injured while travelling in an Enterprise rental vehicle under this agreement, the benefits that would respond will be through Worker's Compensation or the employee's sick leave. This is the same as if an employee were injured while driving a CVA vehicle under the previous service provision.

Please remind employees that are driving Enterprise rentals that no additional insurance is required.

However, employees with other organizations (non-GRF) should contact their human resources branch to inquire about their employee benefits and/or insurance.
