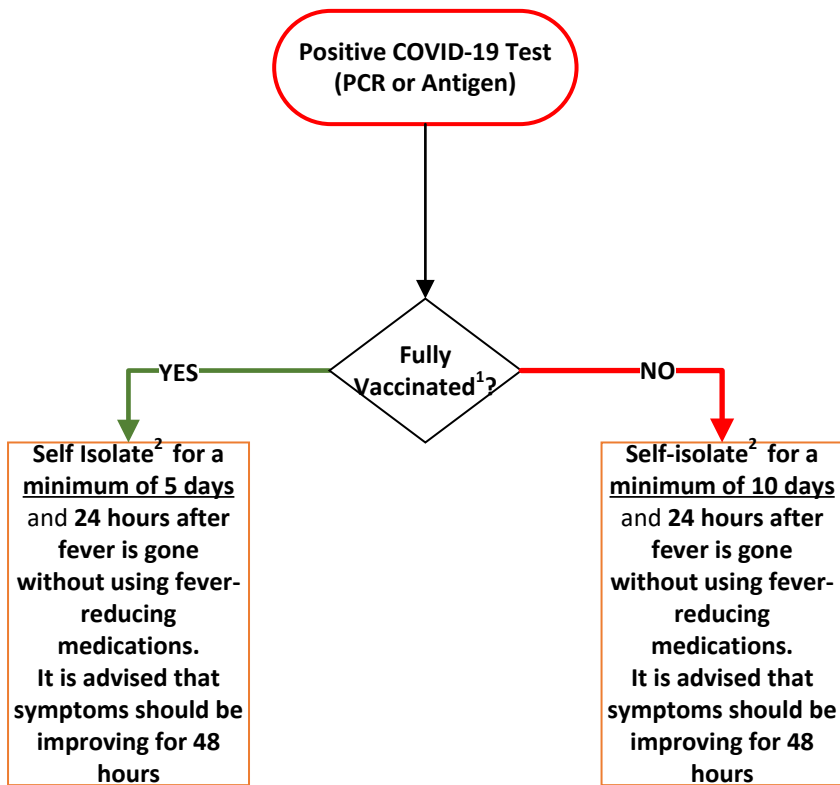


# Isolation Requirements – January 7, 2022

## Cases



<sup>1</sup> Fully vaccinated – at least 14 days after completing an approved vaccine series

<sup>2</sup> Self-isolation – individuals may be eligible for exemption from isolation under the Modified Isolation for Essential Services to attend work if their absence may impact the delivery of essential services which may pose a risk to the health and safety of the public. In these instances additional mitigation measures will be required. An essential service modified isolation plan must be approved before this can be implemented.

<sup>3</sup> Self-monitor – in addition to symptom monitoring, includes self-modified behaviors to reduce risk of transmission for the entire risk period (10 days) even though isolation is shortened. This includes isolating immediately if symptoms are present or develop; continuously masking when outside of their household, and avoiding high risk individuals and high risk settings.

<sup>4</sup> Self-test – all close contacts should self-test immediately and after day 5 and again if symptoms develop.
